Investment Objective and Strategy

The Victory High Income Municipal Bond Fund seeks to provide a high current income exempt from federal income taxes with a secondary objective of capital appreciation. Under normal circumstances, at least 80% of the value of the Fund's assets will be invested in tax-exempt municipal obligations. The Fund may invest up to 100% of its assets in high yield, lower-rated fixed-income securities, including securities that are rated below investment grade, commonly known as "high yield" or "junk" bonds.

About the Fund

- Portfolios built bond-by-bond based on indepth review of issuers' creditworthiness and of security structures.
- Invests primarily in municipal bonds near the lower end of investment-grade ratings and may also allocate up to 100% of its assets to below investment grade and unrated municipal bonds.

The Morningstar Rating[™] for funds, or "star rating," is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed- end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The Morningstar Rating does not include any adjustment for sales loads. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable)

Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods. The Morningstar percentile ranking is based on a fund's average annual total return (excluding sales charges) relative to all funds in the same category. The highest (most favorable) percentile rank is 1%, and the lowest (least favorable) percentile rank is 100%. Fund performance used for the rankings reflects certain fee waivers, without which, Morningstar rankings would have been lower and Morningstar ratings may have been lower.




Credit Quality (% Fund)

Credit Quality ratings are obtained using Bloomberg methodology using ratings derived from Moody's Investors Service (Moody's), Standard & Poor's (S&P) and Fitch Ratings (Fitch). When ratings from all three agencies are available, the median rating is used. When ratings are available from two of the agencies, the lower rating is used. When one rating is available, that rating is used. Victory Capital Management does not evaluate these ratings

but simply assigns the to the appropriate credit quality category as determined by the rating agency. **Average Effective Duration** is a duration calculation for bonds that have embedded options. This measure of duration takes into account the fact that expected cash flows will fluctuate as interest rates change and is, therefore, a measure of risk. **Subsidized Yield** reflects fee waivers/reimbursements/limits in effect. **Unsubsidized Yield** does not reflect any fee waivers/reimbursements/limits in effect.

The Bloomberg Municipal Bond Index (Bloomberg Municipal Bond) is considered to be generally representative of investment-grade-municipal issues having remaining maturities greater than 1 year and a national scope. The Bloomberg High Yield Municipal Bond Index is an index consisting of noninvestment-grade, unrated or below Ba1 bonds.

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
